Duties primarily include teaching and research. Research associates may also pursue independent research and further academic qualifications.

He/she should plan, organize, conduct and analyze research projects independently and publish the findings of these projects in peer-reviewed scientific journals. The applicant is further expected to prepare a proposal for third party funding. The position involves teaching of 3h/wk.
